

The **U.S. Trade and Development Agency (www.ustda.gov)** invites you to attend a Business Briefing Forum for U.S. industry with a delegation of 20 clean energy executives from the public, provincial and private sectors in China.

The Business Briefing is part of a Study Tour by Chinese energy officials to support U.S. private sector participation in the implementation of clean energy projects in China. The Study Tour and the Business Briefing will introduce Chinese delegates to leading U.S. companies offering advanced, efficient green data center and energy storage technologies and services. The briefing event will focus on related data center projects and future requirements in China as the country seeks to expand and improve the overall efficiency of its national and regional clean energy efforts for which new investments are just beginning, and policies and regulations in many of these areas are still in the relatively early stages of development.

The activity will expose U.S. suppliers of data center and energy storage technologies and services to market, project development and procurement opportunities in the clean energy sector in China. The delegates will share their experiences in developing their own national and regional energy markets, from both a technical and regulatory perspective.


