  - The Genetic Medicine Building is a 359,000 square foot laboratory. Occupants of the building include the School of Pharmacy, and the departments of Genetics, Biochemistry and Biophysics and Pharmacology. The university recently completed an energy conservation project, with McKim & Creed as the engineering consultant, in which the airflow rates were reduced and the HVAC system was recommissioned. Results from the first nine months of operation post completion indicate an energy savings of approximately \$190,000. The tour will explore the function of the building and the challenges and successes of the energy conservation project.
